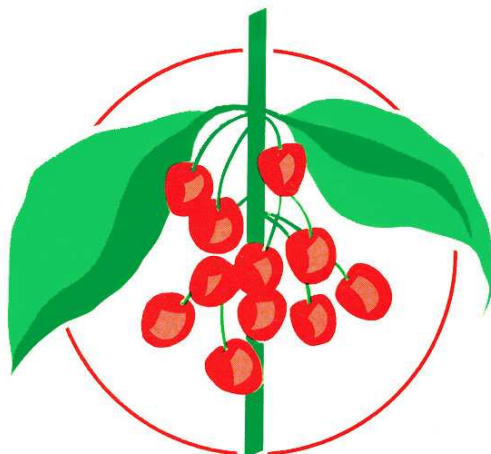

## **President's Report**

Last week's talk and demonstration was by Margaret Conway, Nurse at Mount Lilydale College. Mount Lilydale College is a large community of students and teachers and a full time nurse is needed both to administer first aid and provide training to teachers and pupils. Her topic was First Aid and CPR and she certainly got the full attention of those members present. She talked about Basic Life Support, the acronym DRSABCD and took us through all the steps of each stage.

Most of us think we know a bit about first aid but the information she conveyed was an eye opener.

The frequency of compressions in CPR and the force needed, enough to crack ribs of the patient in some cases, was news to many of us. We will also be more willing to use a modern Defibrillator in an emergency, as the modern ones talk the operator through all the steps and alerts the operator if the instructions are not being followed correctly. Amazing technology. Margaret was warmly thanked by John Hassan and expressed a willingness to visit us again in the future.

Members strongly supported the Board's decision to donate US\$500 to the Polio Plus program given the leverage of matching contributions that bring the total contribution attributable to our action to US\$3750. The District has reserved funds to match the first 20 Clubs who contribute, and following the meeting I have received confirmation that we will be one of those successful clubs.

This week is one of our regular Club Forums and a reminder that President Ray would like members to submit topics for discussion. We have a healthy and active club, but there are always opportunities to improve, so please give this some thought. Hopefully Ray will be fully recovered and leading this discussion.
