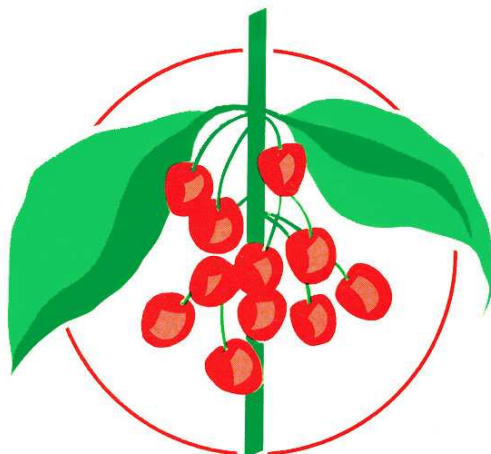

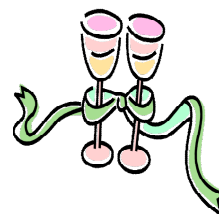

## *President's Report*

I would like to thank Warwick Bisley for looking after proceedings last week and Kevin Parker and Alan Henderson who assisted me with this week's Club Forum.

Whilst it was disappointing the number of members who could not make the meeting, it was encouraging the participation of every member who was in attendance.

Peter Manders and Cliff Riseborough provided a briefing on the sale of the site of the Wandin War Memorial and some of the history associated with the site since its inception.

The discussion on the relative need for "IT Training" questioned the actual need for the web site, as well as the contents that should be available for view to the general audience. There is still a degree of lack of understanding of social media and there was a general consensus that another session on facebook would be beneficial.

We discussed how far can we go with succession planning and everyone was generally supportive of the concept especially for the key position. There was the suggestion that continuity in the positions is important and for each committee there should be a deputy chairman appointed who would be the next chairman and no more than a 50% change in members of the committee each year

There has been a need to clarify the allocation of fundraising funds. It was agreed that there are a number "core projects" that the club funds each year and this has been achieved by events such as the Australia Day Breakfast, Wood Raffle and Xmas Raffle. Whilst all these need the involvement of the whole club, the co-ordinating role has been with the one committee. It was suggested that the co-ordinating role for these types of activities be performed by a sub-committee put together for the event

with representation from all committees, as what has been done for the proposed Cider and Beer Festival.

The upcoming Xmas raffle was discussed at length and it was decided that the major beneficiary of the proceeds would be the four local CFA. Each brigade will be contacted and encouraged to donate goods for the raffle and be provided with books of tickets to sell. The more they donate and the more tickets they sell the greater potential for reward. They will also be asked to advise which project that the proceeds will be allocated to. How do we address the issue of non attending members was discussed. There are some members who do not apply for leave of absence and do not attend for an extremely long time. No decision was reached.

In the past there has been fellowship weekends away. It was asked if there was anything planned as nothing has happened in the last couple of years. After discussion it was passed to the member designated for "Fellowship"

Once again thank you for all your contribution.  
Thanks to Russell for helping with the Bar.  
Acting Sergeant Gavan raised \$80.75 this week  
The speaker for next week's meeting will be Kate Taylor who attended the recent RYLA.
